I want to be certain that you log into your school account. This account is different from our Google Class account. It is important that you follow the steps below to log into the ILEARN platform for summer school. Below are the steps:

The DOE has created student accounts for every single New York City public school student, including 3K and Pre-K students. You log into the NYCDOE by entering the website, schools.nyc.gov. From there you will see the TeachHub link to the right of the website. Click on it.

The account gives your student access to <u>TeachHub</u>, which is how students access:

- iLearnNYC, the Summer School 2020 online learning platform
- Student report cards (available in the Student Documents icon)
- Multiple educational applications
- G Suite, Microsoft O365, and Zoom (using secure central accounts).

It is important that you sign in via the student. From there it will prompt you for your student id (OSIS) and your date of birth. From there it will let you know your user ID. Your email address will be given. It is your userid@nycstudents.net. Then you will continue to create a password that you will remember. Then sign in. Click on ILEARN app. From there this will be your page for summer school. You should see the courses you are scheduled to take. Let me know if you need further assistance. Thank you.
